### **STEWARDSHIP**

- ❖ Cut down poison parsnip plants on the Ridley Brook properties. Native vegetation has really taken hold on the bank that had been clear-cut after Tropical Storm Irene.
- ❖ Reorganized and revised the land acquisition criteria information.
- ❖ Assessed Town Forest access and identified areas for improvement.
- ❖ Removed two dilapidated bridges on the Town Forest.
- ❖ Researched property boundaries to complete marking in-fee property boundaries.
- ❖ Monitored in-fee and easement properties.
